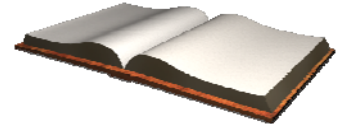
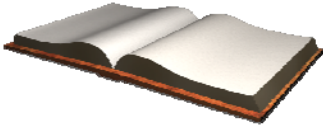
Student Meal Funds Needed for the Rest of the School Year 2010
