Therefore, the items listed below are optional supplies to help your child prepare and organize assignments in Kindergarten. Please send in these items during the first week of school.

Please Note—

- Do not label the items, as they will go into “community” sharing buckets, with the exception of the backpack, of course.
- Pay careful attention to the size and brand of the supplies, as we have learned these brands work best. Thank you!

Kindergarten Supply List

- 1 standard size backpack (No rolling backpacks, please!!!) Be sure to send the backpack to school daily to get work and messages home.
- 12 **Elmer’s** glue sticks (or more if possible—they diminish quickly!)
- 2 boxes of **24 count Crayola (NO ROSEART)** crayons (regular colors—no fluorescent and no jumbo sizes)
- 1 large box facial tissues (Kleenex, Puffs)
- 1 box *quart* size Ziploc-type bags (**girls only**)
- 1 box *gallon* size Ziploc-type bags (**boys only**)
- 1 box *sandwich* size Ziploc-type bags (**all students**)
- 2 **plastic pocket** folders—(**solid colors and no brads**)
- 1 package of **low odor** dry erase markers (preferably EXPO brand, multi-colored is fine)
- 1 package of **Crayola** markers (not thin)
- 1 ream of white 8 ½ x 11 inch copy paper
- 12 Dixon **Ticonderoga** pencils
